Yury Shadrin

Pianist Yury Shadrin, an internationally acclaimed soloist and recitalist, has graced major stages across four continents, including prestigious venues like the Kennedy Center and Carnegie Hall. In recent seasons, he has captivated audiences with performances at renowned institutions such as Russia's Mariinsky Theatre, China's Central Conservatory of Music, and The Juilliard School, among others.

Mr. Shadrin's recent engagements include performing with the Staatskapelle Berlin during their 450th season, headlining the Steinway Series at Silo Hill, and residencies at esteemed institutions like the Royal Conservatory of Ghent and London's Royal College of Music. As an orchestral soloist, he has collaborated with renowned ensembles worldwide, including the Baltimore, Kalamazoo, and Miami Symphony Orchestras, among others.

With numerous accolades to his name, Mr. Shadrin has garnered international recognition as a first prize winner of the Rome International Piano Competition and the Grand Prize winner at the Siberian Piano Competition. His exceptional talent and dedication to his craft have solidified his reputation as a leading pianist on the global stage.

Tian Lu

Praised by the Miami Herald as "a clearly gifted and promising artist," pianist Tian Lu has garnered international acclaim with prizes in prestigious piano competitions worldwide. Renowned for her mastery of Spanish repertoire, she has performed in esteemed venues across North and South America, Europe, and Asia, including Carnegie Hall, Kennedy Center Terrace Theatre, and the Hong Kong Cultural Center. Collaborating with her husband Yury Shadrin, they have delivered performances and lectures at renowned institutions such as the Juilliard School and the Central Conservatory of Music.

As a soloist and chamber musician, Ms. Lu has graced the stage with acclaimed orchestras and toured extensively. Ms. Lu's musical journey began at the Shanghai Conservatory of Music, and she later pursued her studies at the Oberlin Conservatory of Music and the Peabody Conservatory of Music, mentored by Professor Monique Duphil and legendary pianist Leon Fleisher. Currently, she serves as co-artistic director of The Leon Fleisher Academy and the Baltimore International Piano Festival. Yury Shadrin is the Director of the Leon Fleisher Academy.
