Journeys of Paul

Trinity Lutheran Long Lake with Rev. Adam Butler April 22 - May 3, 2025



Day 1, April 22: Departure

Depart from Minneapolis, MN (MSP) for an overnight flight to Thessaloniki, Greece.

Day 2, April 23: Beginning the Footsteps of Paul - Thessaloniki

On arrival, we will be met at the airport for a transfer to our hotel. Dinner & overnight in Thessaloniki.

Day 3, April 24: Thessaloniki - Kavala - Philippi

Begin the day in the port of Kavala where Paul landed with Timothy and Silas, and where Luke the evangelist sailed to from Troas. See a Byzantine castle, the Roman Aqueduct, and the ruins of an acropolis. Follow the Via Egnatia, a remnant of Rome's highway system, viewing Roman and Greek tombs and ruts of ancient chariot wheels. Next, stop in Philippi, where Paul preached his first evangelical sermon, baptized the very first Christian convert on European soil, and was thrown in prison with Silas. Return to Thessaloniki to explore the ancient city, view the basilica of St. Demetrius, the White Tower, and Arch of Galerius. Dinner & overnight in Thessaloniki.

Day 4, April 25: Thessaloniki City Tour - Veria - Meteora - Kalambaka

Veria is known for its numerous Byzantine and post-Byzantine churches, resulting in the name of a 'Small Jerusalem', as well as unique collections of Byzantine icons. Particularly famous is the Church of the Resurrection. We'll spend some time marveling at Meteora, the 24 perpendicular rocks where 600 years ago Byzantine monks chose to worship God and build their cave-like Monastic community. We visit to two of these timeless monasteries to see the exquisite specimens of Byzantine art on display. Overnight in Kalambaka.

Day 5, April 26: Delphi - Athens

We begin exploring the ancient site of Delphi. The sanctuary, where the oracle of Apollo spoke, was the site of the omphalos, the 'navel of the world'. Delphi in the 6th century B.C. was the religious center and symbol of unity of the ancient Greek world. We then travel directly to the center of Athens to start our half-day panoramic city tour of Athens. Then we're off to see the Panathenaic Stadium, where the first Olympic Games of modern times were held in 1896, then the Temple of Olympian Zeus, and Hadrian's Arch. Dinner & overnight in Athens.

Day 6, April 27: Athens - Acropolis - Mars Hill

Rising some 377 feet above the land below and not far from the Acropolis and Agora (marketplace), Mars Hill served as the meeting place for the Areopagus Court, the highest court in Greece. It is the location of one of Paul's most important messages during his second missionary journey. Then visit the ancient Roman agora. On the Acropolis, visit the Architectural Masterpieces of the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion, and finally the Parthenon. Return to the hotel. Free Afternoon. Overnight in Athens.

Day 7, April 28: Athens - Start the 4-night cruise - Mykonos

Begin the day with a drive to the Port of Lavrio and step aboard The Olympia, to start a 4-day Greek Islands cruise. Spend the afternoon exploring the Island of Mykonos, world-renowned for its lovely windmills, small cobblestone streets, and countryside. Return to the ship for dinner & overnight.

Day 8, April 29: Ephesus (Turkey) - Patmos (Greece)

Step off the ship at Kusadasi and into nearby Ephesus, Turkey. This Greek and Roman city has been remarkably preserved. Step along the broad marble where Paul walked. Gaze at the Temple of Artemis (Diana), the Temple of Hadrian, and The Celsus Library. Marvel at the massive theater where Paul was opposed as he spoke boldly about Christ. In the afternoon, enjoy cruising aboard The Olympia to the island of Patmos, built on a mass of volcanic rock, where the apostle John wrote the book of Revelation. Visit the Monastery of St. John and the cave where he was imprisoned. Return to the ship for dinner & overnight.

Day 9, April 30: Rhodes

After disembarkation, you'll have the opportunity to visit the medieval Rhodes and the acropolis of Lindos, with the ancient temple of Athena built in 300 BC. You will have the opportunity to see the houses of the captains and the Church of Our Mrs. Lindos, the acropolis with the Doric temple of Athena. Then, in the city of Rhodes, go through the Porta d'Amboise to walk along the street of the knights, where you will see the residences of the knights separated according to the order, whose shields are still on display. Depart to Crete. Full board on board.

Day 10, May 1: Crete - Santorini

Arrive in Crete, the largest of the Greek Islands and the cradle of the Ancient Minoan Civilization. This island is where the Apostle Paul spent time as he was being transported to Rome as a prisoner and where Titus remained to help the churches. Take a walking tour through town and stop at the Church of St. Titus. Board The Olympia for an afternoon cruise to the famous island of Santorini. Perched atop high cliffs, savor the island's breathtaking views from Oia. Dinner & overnight on the ship.

Day 11, May 2: Athens - Corinth

Disembark and depart for a full-day tour to Ancient Corinth. To begin, we will stop at the famous channel where the Peloponnese and central Greece meet, as well as the Aegean and Ionian seas. We will visit Ancient Corinth with its amazing artifacts, some of which date back to 6000 B.C. The remains of the city, which include the agora (market) and the temple of Apollo (6th century BC) show how rich and important Corinth was in antiquity. On our way back to Athens, we will make a brief stop at the site of the ancient port of Cehries, where Saint Paul disembarked from Thessaloniki. Return to Athens. Overnight in Athens.

Day 12, May 3: Athens - Departure

Following breakfast at our hotel, private transfer to Athens Airport (ATH). We fly home and arrive the same day.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$500.00 per person with registration to secure space. The final payment due on or before **December 15, 2024**. The preferred payment method is via personal check or money order. If registering online via EliasTours.com, deposit may be paid via check or credit card. An electronic invoice will be sent to all travelers with options to pay via check or credit card. All credit card transactions are subject to a 4% platform fee.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: Travel Insurance is not included in the purchase price. For your convenience, we offer travel insurance through Travelex Insurance Services. For questions, quotes, or to purchase travel insurance, Call (800) 228–9792 and use the code 26–0057 for Elias Tours.

CANCELLATION POLICY: (All Cancelation Fees are waived) Deposits and other payments are refundable in full up to ninety days before departure. There will be no refund for cancellations within 90 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to Elias Tours in writing. Travel insurance is highly recommended. <u>Trip cancellation insurance is recommended.</u>

Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motor coaches, utilizing the services of a Government licensed, local, English speaking tour guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable.
