Prayer of the Day

Reading | 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 Now I would remind you, brothers and sisters, of the good news that I proclaimed to you, which you in turn received, in which also you stand, through which also you are being saved, if you hold firmly to the message that I proclaimed to youunless you have come to believe in vain. For I handed on to you as of first importance what I in turn had received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers and sisters at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have died. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me. For I am the least of the apostles, unfit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace toward me has not been in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them-though it was not I, but the grace of God that is with me. Whether then it was I or they, so we proclaim and so you have come to believe.

Now it happened that, with the crowd shoving up against him and listening to

god's words while he was standing by the lake Gennesaret, he saw two boats standing by the lake; the fishermen had climbed out of them and were washing the nets. He boarded one of the boats, which belonged to Simon, and he asked him to put out a little way from the shore. Then he sat and taught the crowds from the boat. And when he'd finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out to the deep water, and let down your nets for a catch." But Simon answered by saying, "Boss, we worked hard the entire night but took in nothing. But I'll take your word for it and let down the nets." And once they did this, they closed them around a huge mass of fish, and their nets were starting to rip. So they gestured to their companions in the other boat to come help them; and they came, and they filled both boats until they began to sink. And when he saw this, Simon Petros fell down at lēsous' knees, saying, "Get away from me, because I'm a wrongdoer, master!" He and all the others with him were naturally overcome with awe because of the fish they'd caught and taken in, and so were lakobos and loannes, the sons of Zebedaios, who were partners with Simon. Then lesous said to Simon, "Don't be afraid! From now on, you'll be capturing human beings - so that they don't die!"" And they brought the boats ashore, left everything behind, and followed him.
